# Koeksister Run/Walk – 24 October

# **Running on the Farm**

While it is safe running on the farm in terms of traffic, we must not forget the hazards that can be found on the route.

Last year we reported the start of a sink hole around 1.3 kilometres into the time trial route and were surprised when a huge hole appeared around the 2.3km.

The route was fenced off to ensure no traffic could pass through on these roads. I have noticed recently that the fencing has become less and in one place, replaced with a log.

Also noted that because the fence is low at the "small hole", people climb over and continue to use this route.

I went to take a closer look and would advise to stay well clear of both holes. If you look at the image below you can see that the hole at 1.3km is much deeper and now runs under the entire road. With the rains starting again, it is only a matter of time before this section collapses.





Where the big hole appeared (just up from the clubhouse) it is clear there is no rush to repair it and it has "grown" over time.

Watch carefully if you do use the gravel path next to this section as I noticed that there are a few cracks developing around the hole and we can expect further sections of this area to collapse as well.
