You have a good base you built so the focus should be on speed and quality sessions. A target race to measure your 10km or 21km would be the race at ZWARTKOP LAPA which is a LEAGUE race as well. The league race is the 30th of July. This can prepare you for the 10km CLUB CHAMPS at the SPIRIT OF FLIGHT which happens on the 3rd of September. This is a good track to run a PB (Personal Best).

We have to stay fit over these challenging colder months. For those who want to qualify earlier for Two Oceans and/or Comrades, there is the club weekend away at the Kaapsehoop Marathon the 4th/5th of November. Nice early marathon to kick the running season off. This will alleviate that pressurised feeling of trying in January and February to qualify with race as dates are so congested. 
Club Captain Linley September finished his 10th Comrades this year
