
ELANA MEYER TALK

Dear Fellow Irene Athletes

IRENE DID IT AGAIN!

The Irene Athletics Club (IAC) is fast becoming a household name in the race walking fraternity. We not only have some of the top race walkers in the country and province but we, as a team or band of walkers and athletes, stood together and presented yet again one of the top Race Walk events, if not one of the best, on the annual calendar in the country. I include events hosted by Athletics South Africa (ASA), SA Masters Athletics (SAMA) Provincial and without fear of contradiction, clubs. We have done it again!

IAC presented the second Irene 10 Km Race Walk Grand Prix at The Oval, Irene Security Estate. What a venue and event! Compliments were showered from all over! The new venue was unanimously rated as one of the fastest inland (altitude) and best tracks in the country. This is, like IAC, unique in the sense that we walked around a tarred oval route within a beautiful, rustic and secured environment.

The inaugural Meeting was held in 2018 after we took the baton from the AGN Race Walk Commission and their quarterly AGN Grand Prix. We are just accelerating down the straight!!!

The focus and aim is to expose race walkers to the technical environment where judges and pit lanes threatens you like a vulture on steroids from above. Here athletes do not get away with poor technique! The IAC Race Walk Objectives focus very strong on development of ALL walkers and not only the Super fasts.

We had a fantastic and enthusiastic turnout on a cool and chilly morning although the chill did not affect the enthusiasm of the helpers and the anticipation was electric. The masters started at eight o'clock and turned out a new RSA Record for Kevin Philips (CGA) in the first event on our new course! Unfortunately not an IAC or at least an AGN athlete but I promise we are hard at work on that!!! The individual and personal competition was intense and athletes chased each other with gusto but in all, good sportsmanship and camaraderie prevailed on the day.

The spirit of the day was impressive and long after the last bell tolled, debriefs and good hearted banter were heard. The organiser had to chase the walkers and spectators home......! The day was a resounding success.

Thank you to Louis Visser for his personal involvement (and bringing Nadine to do her first official Race Walk). Louis and the IAC Committee have the shared vision to develop Race Walk as one of the cornerstones of the club! Thank you for your leadership.




