AGN 10 KM CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Spirit of Flight race to be held on 2 September will serve as the 10 km AGN championships (see flyer attached). This race will also serve as the main event (although not the only one) to select the AGN team to participate in the SA 10 km championships that will take place in Mbombela (Nelspruit) on 4 November.

There will be prize money up for grabs in addition to the race prize money as well as AGN medals (see the attached document for details). Prize money and medals will be awarded in 5-year age categories i.e. 35 - 39, 40 - 45 etc. Athletes must wear the correct age categories on the day i.e. 35, 40, 45, 50, 55 etc. in order to qualify for the AGN medals and prize money. Only registered AGN athletes will be considered.

For the SA championships, there are no set standards, but all senior and junior men should finish in 35 minutes and all senior and junior woman should finish in 45 minutes. All other categories should finish in less than 60 minutes. Please note that it doesn't mean that all athletes who finish in these times will be selected for the AGN team due to restrictions to the size of the team.

NB. The race will also serve as our Club 10 km championships.
