#### GOODBYE AFTER 23 YEARS FROM ASHLEY WILLIAMS

After 23 years as a member of the Irene Athletics Club I have to say goodbye as my wife, and I have relocated to Jeffrey's Bay as from 15 March 2023. My first introduction to Irene was when we bought our house in Rooihuiskraal in April 2000. The estate agent was the wife of the legendary late Dawid Mentz, one of the founder members of the (in)famous "Doringboombende", and she urged me to join the club that had grown from 60 members in 1999 to 120 members. At that stage I was still the vice-chairman of the Kroonstad Collegians Marathon Club (mainly due to me being the Officer Commanding of the School of Engineers and able to supply a venue and troops for the 2 races the club presented each year!!) and I decided to stay with Collegians for the year. However, I did participate in the Irene Valentine's night race as well as the race close to the end of the year (forgotten the name) where I became aware of the great Irene spirit. I should also mention that during the 2000 Wally Hayward 42km race I met up with Dawid Mentz at about 14 kms and he was setting such a good pace that I thought if I stayed with him, I would have a very good marathon time. True to form, at about 20km Dawid greeted me and turned off to the 21km finish (most probably in need of a beer)! At the end of the day, I ended up with my marathon PB of 3:24, so thanks Dawid!

In January 2001 I joined the Irene Athletics Club and became part of the Irene family. Initially it was quite a culture shock for me coming from the "platteland" where Collegians had about 40 members of whom only 25 were active and a good turnout at our races was 150 entrants. In those days Irene was a very young club, meaning that masters (50+) and grand masters (60+) were far and few between. Wynand can correct me, but at that stage I can only recall "Oom" Pieter Hambridge as being the sole active runner over 60 years of age. While we did not have very many masters, I remember one such master, Tienie Strydom, a former SAPS General and Commander of the Police Task Force, who ran most of the youngsters in the club into the ground. He was the definition of an "yster". Even the veterans (40+) were not many and to prove my point, a snail like me won a few certificates in the veteran's category club championships between 2002 and 2003!

Over the years many things have changed at the club. On the negative side the Irene ARC infrastructure has really deteriorated, very much like most of the state-run institutions. I remember the ARC grounds and especially the houses and administration buildings being in pristine condition with not a blade of grass out of place or paint peeling from the walls. Fortunately, the Irene Athletics Club facilities have over the years improved and are still today something to be proud of. The club has also grown tremendously in numbers as well as having become the home of possibly some of the best walkers in North Gauteng, if not South Africa. While many things have changed, there has been one constant and that is Wynand Breytenbach our Club Manager. Wynand was there when I joined and until today, I look forward to the weekly newsletters he brings out. Sometimes I wonder if the club would have reached the great heights without Wynand's dedication. In my book he is "Mister Irene".

If you ask whether I would again join Irene, my answer will be a definite "yes". If you ask whether I have any regrets, it would only be that I was not sufficiently involved in club activities. My military career and later my involvement in global landmine clearance made that I was often away from home for extended periods and could not really dedicate enough time to the club. Besides this I have no regrets and will always remember Irene for the motivation I was given to complete my 10<sup>th</sup> Comrades in 2004. Without the support of my Irene "comrades" I would never have been able to accomplish this. I was also fortunate to have made many good friends over the years, many who have stopped running or left Pretoria. To the new members I can only say that your running friends are friends for life, and if you really want to know someone, run a marathon together.

At 66 going on 67 and after receiving a heart pacemaker and knees that are giving in, I am no longer really able to run, but I consider myself lucky that I can still do some walking with occasional downhill jogging. I believe it is better to be a "has been" than a "never been". However, I remain a member of Irene for 2023 although I will be joining the Jeffrey's Marathon Club, even if just for the camaraderie. Hopefully this is goodbye and not farewell as I leave my wealth (my children and grandchildren) in Centurion and will definitely be visiting regularly.

To all the Irene members I just want to say a big thank you for a wonderful 23 years and enjoy your running and walking at the best athletics and social club in South Africa. Remember to run or walk is a God given privilege and not a right.

## GAUTENG NORTH MASTERS ATHLETICS

I am proud to report back to you on a very successful Gauteng North Masters Athletics Championships held on 21 and 22 April 2023 at Pilditch Athletics Stadium and at the LC de Villiers Athletics Race Walking Track.

Irene AC members, better known as the Irene Steam Express, has built up a good head of steam over the past months in preparation for this championships. Our dedicated race walkers trained many an hour an kilometer in sometimes difficult conditions.

Race Walking is considered one of the most difficult disciplines of the entire athletics track and field domain. It requires continuous and intense concentration for the duration of the whole event. Training many kilometres focus to embed muscle memory of the correct technique. The many hours of hard work paid off very well. The Irene Steam Express has made us proud.

This year, as an experiment, we participated in a 3000 m track race walk event. The 3000 m event can roughly be compared to a 400 m or 800 m running event and requires perfect technique at top speed. A very challenging event indeed. We had 50% of all the ladies' entries and 45% of all the men's entries from Irene AC. Sandra Steenkamp unofficially broke the SA record in her age group. Well done Sandra.

At the 10 km road Race Walk event, the flagship event, the Irene Steam Express really blew off steam! The line-up was blue... IRENE BLUE, and so was the podium!

I want to commend our club members for their spirit and guts at these events. We compete as hard as nails, but we are the dearest of friend of the course.

We are proud of the special contributions and sacrifices made by our dedicated members. This event was planned and presented by Jaap Willemse, a long time club member and serving on the AGN Race Walking Commission. He was supported by many of our club members. The lap counters, water table crew and various other essential functions were ably dealt with by Irene AC members. Great work and thank you.

We also commend Tjaan and Bronwyn Kruger who took responsibility of the Technical Official side of the event. They acted as Chief Judge and Race Walk Specialist Judge at the event and conducted themselves with distinction.

The championships ended on a high note and the club can be proud of a big bag filled to the brim with medals.




